### 2017-2018 Tuition

In order for students to enter school in August, all prior year's financial obligations must be paid in full.

Tuition is payable in 10 equal payments, beginning in August and ending in May.

Tuition payments are to be made on a timely basis, that is, on or before the due date, regardless of who is responsible for the tuition or any portion of the tuition.

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### **NEW SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION** REQUIREMENTS

As of August 2017, a parent must have all immunizations completed within the first 5 days of school.

If the student is in the middle of a series and it is too soon for the next dose, the parents must provide the school nurse with a plan for immunizations (signed by a health care provider) within the first 5 days. If the student has incomplete immunizations and no medical plan, the student will be excluded from school.

You may check your child's school immunization record by logging onto the parent portal through the district website at www.cbsd.org or by consulting with your child's physician.

### **Service Hours**

### SCHOOL VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ATTENDANCE IN PENNSYLVANIA SCHOOLS

### FOR ATTENDANCE IN ALL GRADES CHILDREN NEED THE FOLLOWING:



- 4 doses of tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis\* (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday) 4 doses of polio (4th dose on or after 4th birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose given)\*\*
- · 2 doses of measles, mumps, rubella\*\*\* 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or evidence of immunity



ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL, unless the child has a medical or religious/philosophical exemption, a child must have had at least one dose of the above vaccinations or risk exclusion.

- · If a child does not have all the doses listed above, needs addition al doses, and the next dose is medically appropriate, the child must receive that dose within the first five days of school or risk exclu-sion. If the next dose is not the final dose of the series, the child must also provide a medical plan (red and white card) within the first five days of school for obtaining the required immunizations risk exclusion.
- If a child does not have all the doses listed above, needs addition al doses, and the next dose is not medically appropriate, the child must provide a medical plan (red and white card) within the first five days of school for obtaining the required immunizations or risk
- The medical plan must be followed or risk exclusion

### FOR ATTENDANCE IN 7TH GRADE: FOR ATTENDANCE IN 12TH GRADE:

- · 1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) on the first day of 7th
- grade.
   1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV) on the first day of 7th
- ON THE FIRST DAY OF 7TH GRADE. unless the child has a medical or reli-gious/philosophical exemption, a child nust have had the above vaccines or risk exclusion.

- 1 dose of MCV on the first day of 12th grade. If one dose was given at 16 years of age or older, that shall count as the twelfth grade dose.
- ON THE FIRST DAY OF 12TH GRADE. unless the child has a medical or reli-gious/philosophical exemption, a child must have had the above vaccines or risk exclusion

The vaccines required for entrance, 7th grade and 12th grade continue to be required in each succeeding

These requirements allow for the following exemptions: medical reason, religious belief, or philosophical/strong moral or ethical conviction. Even if your child is exempt from immunizations, he or she may be excluded from school during an outbreak of vaccine preventable disease.
