

HTCS 5th and 6th grade students learned about wind energy and wind turbines while participating in KidWind project and challenge from SFU. Students researched to learn about wind energy, conducted a controlled experiment with wind turbine blades and applied engineering design process to create their own wind turbines. On March 28th, four teams participated in Pennsylvania KidWind challenge at the PSU main campus. They presented their wind turbines and knowledge to the judges. Our teams took 4th, 12th, 15th and 19th place out of 23 teams. Congratulations to our teams for their participation and an outstanding performance for their first year!




