

## **Score Definitions**

Scaled Score: Calculated based on difficulty of questions

and number of correct responses.

Percentile Rank: Normed score compared to other


students in the same grade.

**Grade Equivalent:** Normed score that compares students to others nationally

Instructional Reading Level: Criterion referenced score that is the highest reading level at which your child is 80% proficient (or higher) in comprehending material with assistance.

Lexile Range: A measure of students reading ability. Guides teachers and students to choose an appropriate level of text.
